#### **ANTI-DOPING**

#### • Anti-Doping Procedures

- Please be advised that this Event is subject to anti-doping testing in accordance with the policies and procedures of World Anti-Doping Agency (WADA) regulations and EGY Nado.
- Therefore, there will be, at minimum, the following doping control tests to be carried out at the Event:
  - 02 non-Competition anti-doping tests will run.
  - 04 Competition anti-doping tests will run.
- The list of prohibited substances can be found on the World Boccia website (<u>https://www.worldboccia.com/documents/#AntiDopingDoc</u>). All doping processes will be in accordance with the procedures of the WADA.
- World Boccia Therapeutic Use Exemption (TUE) forms are located on the World Boccia website. Athletes, who are using banned substances found on the WADA Prohibited List for therapeutic reasons, should complete the TUE forms and return them to the World Boccia doping officer.

#### • World Boccia Rules & Regulations

- All events of the Cairo 2024 World Boccia challenger will run in accordance with World Boccia International Boccia Rules, World Boccia Competition Rules, Competition Guide, World Boccia World Ranking and World Boccia Code of Ethics. In case of doubt or disagreement in the interpretation of the rules, the English version shall prevail. The current World Boccia Boccia Rules can be found on the World Boccia website.
- Any case not included in this document shall be solved in accordance with the Technical Delegate.
- It is the responsibility of each World Boccia Member participating in the Event to ensure that all competitors and staff are familiar with World Boccia Boccia Rules as well as the World Boccia Code of Ethics.





**Important Notice**: All athletes to be classified or reclassified must have submitted their updated Certificate of Diagnosis and Consent Form for Classification before the Event World Boccia and to <u>esfacp9898@gmail.com</u>.

- Must provid a document such as a Passport, ID card, Boccia License Card or Event Accreditation.
- Must sign an Informed Consent Form and a certificate of diagnostic which states that the athlete must comply with all reasonable instructions given by a Classification Panel.
- Have the right to be accompanied by a member of the athlete's National Body or National Paralympic Committee when attending an Evaluation Session.
- Must provide information to the Classification Panel regarding impairment medication, medical device/implant, and any surgery that affects sport performance.
- Must arrive at Classification Venue 20 minutes prior to his/her Evaluation Session.

#### **OPENING CEREMONY**

The Opening Ceremony will be held on July 17<sup>th</sup> at **6:00**pm at the FOP Area.

#### **MEDAL CEREMONY**

The Medal Ceremony for Individual Competition will be held on July 18<sup>th</sup>, 30 minutes after the last match of the day at the **FOP**.

The Medal Ceremony of Team and Pairs' Competition will be held on July  $21^{st}$ , 30 minutes after the last match of the day at the **FOP**.

The HOC kindly asks the medallists to be ready for the Medal Ceremonies 15 minutes before its starts. The Call Room will be used as preparation area for the ceremonies.





The HOC reminds the medallists that it is **NOT** allowed to bring any kind of objects to the podium.

Only people that receive a Medal will be allowed at the Podium while Medals are being presented. After the Anthem the assistant/coach may approach the Podium for a brief moment to take pictures with their athletes.

#### **EQUIPMENT CHECK**

- Equipment Check will be done on July 17<sup>th</sup> at the Competition Venue.
  Equipment that does not meet the criteria will not be certified and will be held by the organization until the end of the championship.
- Keep in mind that "All BC3 Sports Assistants are required to bring their passport to the equipment check in order to confirm Nationality eligibility according to the World Boccia Policy - Nationality of competitors" and they must be from the same country as the athlete.

#### **TRAINING SCHEDULE**

- **Important Notice 01**: No training sessions will be allowed on July 15<sup>th</sup> at the venue.
- **Important Notice 02**: No additional training slots will be allocated for the teams in the schedule.

#### **Training on the Competition Courts**

- Teams must be at the entrance of the competition area at least 5 minutes before the scheduled time.
- Five minutes before the finish time, teams must stop training and prepare all the equipment to leave at the scheduled time.
- Access to the entrance of training area will be allowed only to accredited staff or athletes who are scheduled for training.
- During training sessions please keep exclusively to the court(s) that are allocated to your country and make sure that you don't disturb athletes training on other courts.

#### COMPETITION

The countries eligible to compete at the Cairo 2024 World Boccia Challenger must have paid all entry fees in full, submitted all required registration information and are currently full members of World Boccia.

#### **Divisions of Play**

Individual BC1, BC2, BC3, BC4 (Male & Female) and Pairs BC3, Pairs BC4 and BC1-BC2 Teams.

#### Competitor Numbers (BIBs)

- Upon confirmation of classification, each athlete shall be given one (1) piece of competitor number, to be used as follows:
  - The BIB must be worn at all times during the hours of competition. The competitor number must be attached to the front of the shirt or the trouser leg;
  - For classes BC1 and BC3, the assistant/ramp operator will have a second competitor number.
    - BC1 assistant: the BIB must be attached on his/her front;





- BC3 ramp operator: the BIB must be attached on his/her back.
- If an athlete forgets, loses, or chooses not to wear their competitor number, he/she will not be permitted to enter the warm-up area, the Call Room or the field of play.

A side that is not present for the start of the match forfeits the match (rule 7.4). Exceptions may be considered by the Head Referee and/or the Technical Delegate.

#### **Pre-Game Preparation:**

#### A - Warm-up Area Procedures

- From the 18<sup>th</sup> of July on, warm-up area is exclusive for the competitors that are going to play next.
  - Warm up area will be available for the athletes who will play in a round at the same time as the Call Room closes for the previous round.
  - $_{\odot}$   $\,$  For the first round of the day, the warm-up will run in the FOP.
  - Warm-up for Individuals starts 90 min before the Schedule time of the Match and finishes 5 min before the call room opens.
  - Warm-up for Teams and Pairs starts 105 min before the Scheduled time of the Match and finishes 5 min Before the call room opens.
- Players may be accompanied into the warm-up area by a maximum number of people as follows (Rule 6):

BC1	1 Coach (or 1 Coaching Assistant), plus 1 Sport Assistant
BC2	1 Coach (or 1 Coaching Assistant), plus 1 Sport Assistant
BC3	1 Coach (or 1 Coaching Assistant), plus 1 Ramp Operator
BC4	1 Coach (or 1 Coaching Assistant), plus 1 Sport Assistant
Pairs BC3	1 Coach (or 1 Coaching Assistant), plus 1 Ramp Operator per Athlete
Pairs BC4	1 Coach (or 1 Coaching Assistant), plus 1 Sport Assistant
Team (BC1/2)	1 Coach (or 1 Coaching Assistant), plus 1 Sport Assistant

• If necessary, a translator and a physiotherapist/masseuse per Country may enter the warm-up area, however they can't help or assist with coaching.





#### **B - Call Room Procedures**

- Prior to entering the Warm-up Area and Call Room, each Athlete, Sport Assistant and/or Ramp Operator must show their competitor bib numbers and their accreditation tag. Coaches (or Coaching Assistants) must show their accreditation (Rule 7.3).
- A Side must be registered between forty-five (45) and twenty (20) minutes before the scheduled start time of any Team/Pairs match. A Side must be registered between thirty (30) and fifteen (15) minutes before the scheduled start time of any Individual match (Rules 7.4.1 & 7.4.2). Registration is done at the Call Room Desk. A Coach may only register an individual athlete if that athlete is at the entrance to the Call Room area.
- Each Side (Individual, Team, or Pair, including any SA/RO and the Coach/CA) must register together and must bring all their equipment and balls with them (Rule 7.4.3).
- The Official Clock is the Venue digital clock. Any Side who fails to register, or be registered, within the above time limit will automatically be disqualified. If the Side fails to be present within the above time limit, it will forfeit the match (Rule 7.4).
- Once registered and inside the Call Room, athletes, coaches, and sports assistants must not leave the Call Room. Should they do so, they will not gain re-admittance and will take no further part in the match, potentially forfeiting the match. The number of people, as indicated below, may accompany sides into the Call Room. Translators are not subject to this restriction. However, they may only enter the call room if asked to do so by the Referee.
