Santiago of Chile is located in a central valley at 543 meters above sea level, near the Andes foothills, with the Mapocho River running through it. It has a temperate, high-altitude Mediterranean climate, with rainfall mainly between March and September and an average temperature of 14°C. As the country's cultural and economic hub, it offers diverse entertainment options day and night.

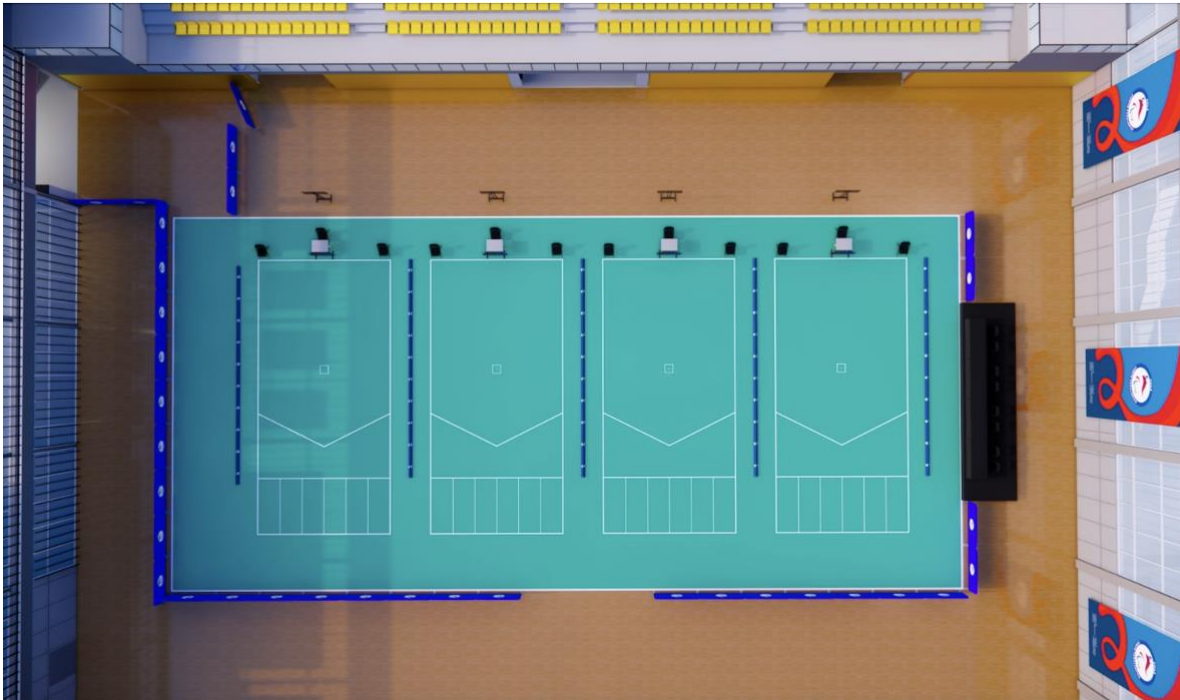

Before participating in the event, each team must purchase personal, medical (including repatriation coverage), and travel insurance covering property loss, injury, medical treatment or hospitalization, trip interruption, or loss of luggage.

The Local Organizing Committee is not responsible for injuries or loss of wages resulting from them, so all participants must sign a liability waiver. All participating nations must purchase medical and accident insurance, including repatriation coverage, during their stay. This insurance must cover all athletes and staff.

Out of competition	Out of competition test occur during the training period.
	The two individuals will be drawn from the Top 12 ranked athletes in the World Ranking (as ranked 2 weeks before the competition) present at the competition, in each of the eight individual medal events. There should be at least 8 athletes in the draw. Should there not be eight individuals at the competition, the 2 athletes will come from the top 12 ranked in the entry list, from each classification group.
In competition	Selection of athletes will occur during the semi final match and athletes will be notified following their final match.
	One athlete per class is drawn. Female and male athletes from the same class will be in the same testing group.
